

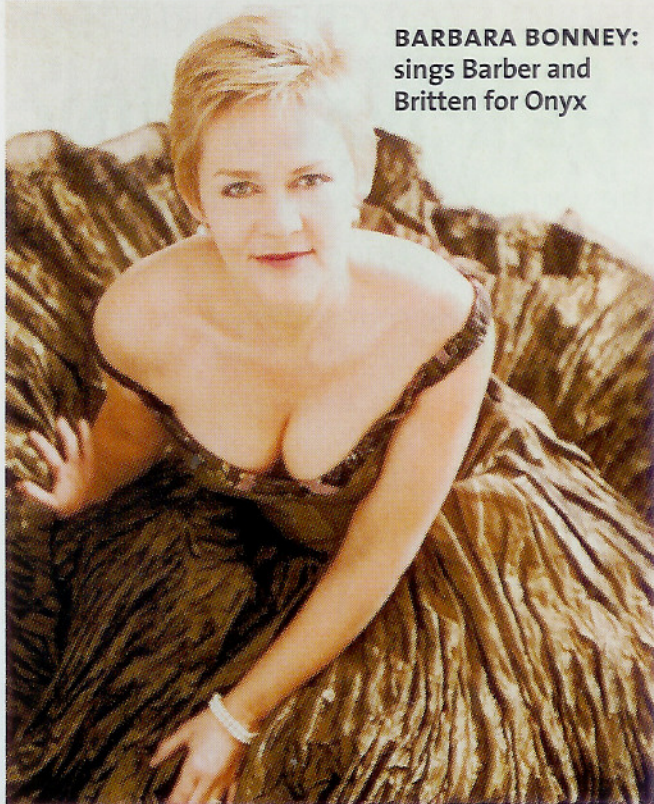
NEW RECORD LABEL

TOP ARTISTS FLOCK TO ONYX

MUSICIANS ONCE CLOSELY associated with labels such as Philips and Decca have signed to a new label, Onyx. Soprano Barbara Bonney, the Borodin Quartet, violinist Viktoria Mullova and pianist Pascal Rogé feature on the first four releases being launched on 16 May.

Mullova's album features Vivaldi Concertos performed with Il Giardino Armonico (ONYX 4001). The Borodin Quartet celebrate their 60th anniversary with a disc of Borodin's Quartet No. 2 coupled with Schubert's *Quartettsatz*, Webern's *Langsamer Satz* and encores by Tchaikovsky and Rachmaninov (ONYX 4002). Bonney teams with Malcolm Martineau in a programme of British and American songs by Britten, Quilter, Barber, Bernstein, Copland and Charles Griffes (ONYX 4003). And the 'Rogé Edition' is launched with the first release in Pascal Rogé's complete Debussy cycle, starting with the complete *Préludes* (ONYX 4004).
